MASTER PLAN FOR WELSHMILL WALKWAY

A Big Lottery Grant of nearly £50,000 enabled the first part of the plan to improve the Welshmill Walkway to go ahead in 2012. The play park is gradually being improved and the new bike track is a roaring success. This part of the project came about through a partnership with Frome Town Council and F.R.O.G.S. The grant came from Community Spaces which is part of the Big Lottery, and is managed by Groundwork UK.

A Sustainability Grant from the same source in 2013 enabled activities to be run throughout the year in the Park, encouraging local groups to work together, and getting a wide range of people into the Park
