## Butterflies, Birds and Plants at East Woodlands

This Sunday, 9 June, Eve Tigwell will help us identify the butterflies, birds and plants of these beautiful woods. In previous years we have seen as many as 17 different varieties of butterfly and moth, many of them quite unusual, like the White Admiral.

The walk will start at 2.30pm from the church. There is some parking beside the church (BA11 5LQ), and along the lane to the right as you approach the church - please park considerately, and don't park at the village hall!

Waterproofs might be advisable, as well as stout footwear. If you can, bring a pair of binoculars. Adults £3, children free.

We love to see children at these walks, but the adults who bring them must remain responsible for them.
