Wildlife of a Quarry

The very next day, Sunday 28 July, Tony House will lead a FROGS Wildlife Walk to see Mearhead Quarry - the biggest manmade hole in Europe - and its wildlife. We meet at 2pm for a 2.30pm start up Slait Hill, a turning off the A361 Shepton Mallet road, signposted 'Downhead'. The walk will start at the top of Slait Hill, past the bends - please park carefully on the roadside. Approximate postcode is BA4 4LL

Stout footwear is recommended. If you can, bring a pair of binoculars. Adults £3, children free, but must be accompanied.

We love to see children at these walks, but the adults who bring them must remain responsible for them.
